The Anti-Corruption Academy of Nigeria, the ICPC Academy, was established pursuant to Section 6 of the Corrupt Practices and Other Related Offences Act 2000 which empowers the Commission to carry out preventive, enforcement and enlightenment functions.

In order to facilitate the effective implementation of the Commission's functions, the Anti-Corruption Academy of Nigeria (ACAN) was established, to equip ICPC staff with the necessary skills and knowledge that would enable them to perform at required levels. The Academy is also designed to provide training for public officers, public servants and the general public on good governance, accountability, transparency, integrity, ethics and all issues relating to corruption and corrupt practices, as well as build up a body of knowledge that will facilitate the development of knowledge-based anti-corruption policies in the country.

LOCATION

The Anti-Corruption Academy of Nigeria (ACAN) is Located in a serene environment in Keffi, Nasarawa State, 46 Kilometres from Abuja city centre. It lies adjacent to the National Youth Service Corps Orientation Camp, Keffi.

■ **Anti-Corruption Research**

The Research Division is engaged in the conduct of cutting-edge research in the general area of anti-corruption and disseminating the outcome of same for the purpose of building the body of knowledge in the area that will aid the development of appropriate policy responses and acquisition of skills necessary for tackling corruption nationally and internationally. The Academy, which also serves as a platform for regular scholarly exchange in the field of anti-corruption studies and leading public opinion, engages in efficient and widespread dissemination of anti-corruption resources and literature nationally and internationally. As a mark of our commitment to this cause, free internet service is available for our participants while in the premises of the Academy to encourage research and information dissemination.

■ **Consultancy Services**

The Anti-Corruption Academy of Nigeria, through its consultancy programme is helping various organisations (Public & Private) including State Governments to design and implement anti-corruption strategies. The purpose is to achieve a corruption-free society so that Anti-corruption agencies would have less work arresting corrupt people.

■ **Corruption Risk Assessment (CRA):-** ACAN also conducts Corruption Risk Assessment (CRA) for various agencies including state government agencies and private organisations. C.R.A is a (diagnostic) tool which seeks to identify weaknesses within a system which may present opportunities for corruption to occur. The purpose of a CRA is usually to supplement evidence of actual or perceived corruption in a given context in order to inform anti-corruption strategies and policies or for action such as advocacy. It can also serve as a baseline for anti-corruption work to track risk trends over time. Corruption risk assessment can be applied at all levels from government institutions, to donor support programmes, down to sectoral programmes, as well as in individual organizations or units.

■ **Collaboration with External Agencies**

The Anti-Corruption Academy of Nigeria collaborates with relevant agencies and professional bodies to organise workshops, seminars and training programmes for various groups whose activities relate to the war against corruption and corrupt practices in Nigeria.

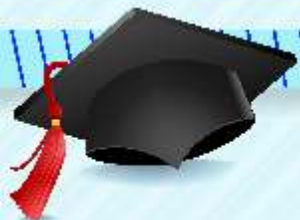
